PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Introduction

Welcome to the Annual General Meeting of South Melbourne Athletic Club for 2016.

The club has once again celebrated a very successful year, with junior and senior members competing at national and international championship events.

There have been some wonderful personal achievements amongst our members and teams across winter and summer competitions and I will allow Corey Lawson to expand on this further in his Competitions Report

Finance

The club has recorded a small operating deficit of \$75.63 for the year.

Club membership fees have remained static in recent years and will remain so for the 2016/17 season although the Athletics Victoria membership structure has changed and will provide greater flexibility for new and returning members to select winter, summer or combined memberships.

Whilst it remains to be seen how the new AV fee structure will impact our numbers, as a club with a strong middle distance membership, the new fee structure is likely to be beneficial for winter registration numbers.

During 2015, the club was pleased to be able to support our international representatives Sinead Diver & Kirstin Bull at World Championship events. This is in line with the club's policy to support our athletes at the highest level.

Last year the club was successful, thanks to the assistance of Caroline Larcher at South Melbourne Districts Sports Club (SMDSC) in obtaining a grant from the City of Port Phillip for \$1,000 to help support disadvantage athletes.

This grant has carried over for and the club has utilised some of this of the grant to support one athlete in 2015/16.

Further details are provided in the Treasurer's Report. I would also like to acknowledge the hard work of our Treasurer, **Greg Payne** who continues to manage the club's finances with support from **Stuart Nicol** who has assisted with the Club's migration to new accounting software.

Membership

Membership for 2015/16 (YE March) season peaked at 112, an increase of 28 on the 2014/15 membership of 84. Our junior members as a % of total athletes are also up 5% which is very pleasing.

Registrations for the current season opened late Saturday night (2nd April) and at the time of writing, our membership had reached 20 of which 6 are new members.

We also continue to get great support from **Tim Crosbie** and his recreational running group, Crosbie Crew, who once again have provided new members for the club this season.

Website

This continues to be a work in progress and proved very useful in assisting with new member information and registrations last season. I would like to thank **Amanda Kramer** and **Eran Lande** for their continued assistance in updating calendars, publishing news items and keeping the website current.

Separately, SMDSC is exploring the redevelopment of its website and the intention will be to include a link to the SMAC website as was previously the case.

Club Connect

The club has recently submitted and had signed off the first stage of the AV Club Connect mandatory requirements.

Athletics Victoria introduced the AV Club Connect Program, in October 2014 to help build and maintain strong governance, effective management and planning within AV clubs. By the end of the 2017/18 season, all AV clubs will have met the required standards.

The program focuses on 5 main areas –

- Governance,
- Communication
- Membership
- Volunteers
- Partnerships

For the year end 31 January 2016, the club committee has endorsed the following as part of AV Club Connect:-

Communications Policy
Working with Children Register
Volunteer Handbook
Role Descriptions (office bearers)

The above are now located on the club website and we will continue to add to this across the next 12 month period.

Club Survey

One of the requirements of the AV Club Connect program was for each club to survey its members and we undertook this task early in the New Year, coinciding with the conclusion of the summer track season.

The response rate was ~30% which whilst low, did provide some very useful feedback and more importantly a focus on areas for improvement which the incoming committee will ensure is acted upon.

Key findings of the survey will be published on the club website shortly.

Committee

The efforts of the committee and their dedication to the club should be recognised by all members. In my second year as president, the committee has once again been a great support.

As well as attend regular meetings, they have been a strong presence across winter and summer competitions

Sadly, **Corey Lawson** informed me the other day that not only is he stepping down from the committee as club secretary but is also leaving South Melbourne to join Mentone Athletic Club. Corey has he has been a member of SMAC for 4 years and served on the committee for much of that time, including 2+ years as Club Secretary. Corey's contribution to the culture, growth and success of SMAC has been invaluable. He will be missed by all of us, as will Emma, but both are always welcome to call by the SMAC tent for a chat and some cake at future events.

I would like to thank **Danny Bowerin** who has decided to step down having served on the committee for the past 2 years. Danny has been a great contributor to the committee and the wider club, and we wish him all the best with recovery from injury and hope to see him out running in the red and white colours again soon.

Coaching

Norm Maguire has been a valuable to addition to the club this past 12 months, not only as a track athlete competing over the summer shield season, but also in a coaching capacity. Norm continues to work with a number of our athletes at Lakeside Stadium and we look forward to having Norm on board again this season.

Srini Mandava has done a fantastic job with many of the club's junior athletes over the past 12 months, highlighted by the club's successes at recent state and national championships.

South Melbourne Districts Sports Club

We maintain a very good relationship with South Melbourne Districts Sport Club and myself, Stuart Nicol and Greg Payne attended various committee meetings through the year.

Senior Athletics remains very well supported by SMDSC and I thank **Hugo Armstrong**, Districts President and his committee for this support.

The Year Ahead

I am very pleased to announce our team captains for 2016 winter season - Alana Plymin, Clair Thomas, Mark Hayes & Joe Rainer and I look forward to working with them to ensure the winter season is a big success for our club.

With registrations for the 2016/17 season having recently opened, our immediate focus remains recruitment of new members and retention of our existing members. We are committed to ensuring that the club maintains a healthy membership base, continues to promote a supportive and inclusive club culture and enable our members to achieve their athletic goals.

In closing, let me thank all of the Committee members and those in attendance at this AGM for their ongoing support and commitment to the Club.

COMPETITION REPORTS

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

In early February, our junior athletes competed at the Victorian Junior Track & Field Championships at Lakeside Stadium with many medaling or obtaining qualifying times for Nationals the following month.

Grace Turner -silver in the U14 1500m

Gigi Maccagnini -gold in the U15 400m and 800m

Tamzin Hall -bronze in the U17 300m

Will Richards -bronze in the U14 800m

Jack Saunders -silver in the U15 800m

Ramen Nayar -bronze in the U15 1500m and 3000m

Felix Lonergan -silver in the U18 800m and bronze in the 400m

Mitchell Waring, Saskia Lloyd, Maysen Duffy and Chelsea Saw ran national qualifying times throughout the season taking our total athletes to 11.

The Australian Junior Track & Field Championships were held over a hot March week in Perth and yet again, our junior athletes shone.

Gigi Maccagnini won a pair of gold medals in the U14 girls 400m in 59.30 and 800m in 2.17.15.

Grace Turner won the girls U12 1500m in 5.05.46 and second in the 800m.

Maysen Duffy was second in the U15 girls 1500m in 4.51.86.

Ramen Nayar won the U13 1500m

Max Pegoli U14 2nd 100m and 3rd 200m

Well done to all our junior athletes and to Srimi Mandava for the time he devotes to training and encouraging these athletes to cross over to this club from SMD Little Athletics.

WINTER XCR

XCR15 was our biggest year yet. Despite various family commitments, injuries, etc., SMAC had little trouble fielding quality teams at every round, demonstrating the depth in distance running at South Melbourne.

Particular results to note:-

- Kirstin Bull becoming an Australian record holder for the 100km distance. (8th in the IAU World 100km Championships in a time of 7 hours 39 mins, averaging 4.35 per km)
- Sinead Diver placing 1st Australian and 21st in the world in the Marathon at the IAAF World Championships in difficult conditions in Beijing with a time of 2:36:38.

- Sinead also won the first three races in the XCR15 season, making a consecutive total 8 wins between the 2014 and 2015 XCR seasons (this is unprecedented in Athletics Victoria XCR history)

South Melbourne had very good depth, fielding teams across most divisions, although at times were challenged to field full teams as the big season took its toll.

With only one female member just a few years ago, it's hard to believe how much SMAC has grown to be such an inclusive club. Catering for both men and women of every level from elite to recreational plodders, the SMAC spirit flows strong and proud.

A part of Yellow Zone, South Melbourne struggled to get numbers for the 2015/2016 summer track season due to various reasons although still produced some great results and had a lot of fun.

The track season is great for getting in some good quality training/racing through the summer months to assist in preparing the body to run stronger through the entire winter seasons and into marathon preparation (if that way inclined).

Despite the great atmosphere and fun had at each AV Shield meet, it continues to remain a challenge for the club to build participation at over the summer track and field competition. However, the high participation rates at each of the Victorian Milers Club events mustn't go unnoticed. This demonstrates the strong middle distance / distance passion and talent, (hopefully) (meaning) higher participation in future track and field competition.
